

Hurricane 'Isaac'

Abraham had received the promises, yet, in order for him to know that these promises were ratified within him, Abraham had to die first. This happened at Mount Moriah. There he trusted our Father that He would keep the Promises despite the impending sacrifice of his only begotten son. There at Mount Moriah he trusted our Father to be Sovereign as He knew Him to have the power over the Life and Death of Isaac and so, by implication, that He was Sovereign in him, leaving no place for 'self will'. There at Mount Moriah a sacrifice did occur, though, it was not the sacrifice of Isaac but it was the sacrifice of Abraham's 'self' consciousness. There he died to 'self' and knew himself to be One with His Father. This historic event happened on that mountain 'Moriah', a name which means '*Yah is revealed to Chaotic Man*'. By having become One with the Father, Abraham knew himself to be the recipient and owner of All things.

This offering of the 'self' consciousness of Abraham on Mount Moriah is crucial for all of us and prophecies of the death of 'self' of the 'First Fruits' of Israel, which is coming to fulfilment at this present time. Abraham's sacrifice of 'self' inaugurated the ratification of the Promise for the people of Israel. The death of 'self', of those who know themselves to belong to the First Fruits, inaugurates the beginning of their realization thereof.

This dying to 'self' is characterised through the offering of that which is loved most. For Abraham this offering of love was his son Isaac.

Genesis 22:2 "*And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest...*"

Hurricane 'Isaac' has marked the start of the fulfilment of the Promise ratified by the death of 'self' of Abraham at Mount Moriah.

This accounts for all of us as we all need to die for that which we love most. Our offering is, like Abraham's offering, an offering of love from which our flesh cannot part. This love is based upon the illusion of having an ability to pursue and secure it, and thus this love is, in essence, the love of 'self' and for this love we will die.

It was remarkable timely that last week our Father breathed over the United States with a hurricane named 'Isaac'. With His breath, or His Spirit, He re-member-ed at this time some of the people of Israel on the offering of Isaac whereby the 'self' of Abraham was sacrificed. Every time the mentioning of the name of 'Isaac' in the news was heard, it was as if our Father spoke the words: "Remember Isaac". It was as if Father spoke to the heart of all those who are dying, proclaiming to them the soon coming substantiation of their desire, a desire which they have in common with their fathers, a desire for their true inheritance, their Birthright.

Hebrews 11:16 "*But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore Elohim is not ashamed to be called their Elohim: for he hath prepared for them a city*"....

This is the time that their '*better country*' has arrived and their new set of doctrines or their '*city*' is ready

Through Hurricane Isaac our Father called His People, '*...In Isaac thy seed shall be called*' (Hebr. 11:18), the 'seed' are the twelve tribes of Israel. Yesterday, in the evening news bulletin, it was stated that 12 tornadoes were spawned by this hurricane. These 12 tornadoes are the 12 calls to the First Ones of His tribes, to re-member Isaac, in order for them to receive their Birthright.
